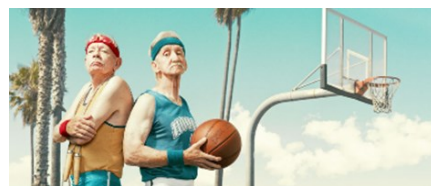


PRAYER WALK
