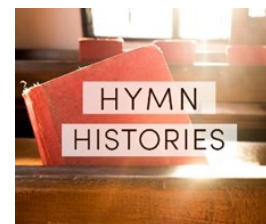
SWEETHEART BANQUET

HYMN STORIES

Our middle hymn today, "I Must Tell Jesus" was written by Elisha Hoffman (1839 –1929). He was from Pennsylvania, a Civil War Vet, the son of a minister, who would become a minister and hymn writer. He also wrote many other hymns, including "Are You Washed in the Blood?" and "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms." This is what Hoffman said was the inspiration for "I Must Tell Jesus."

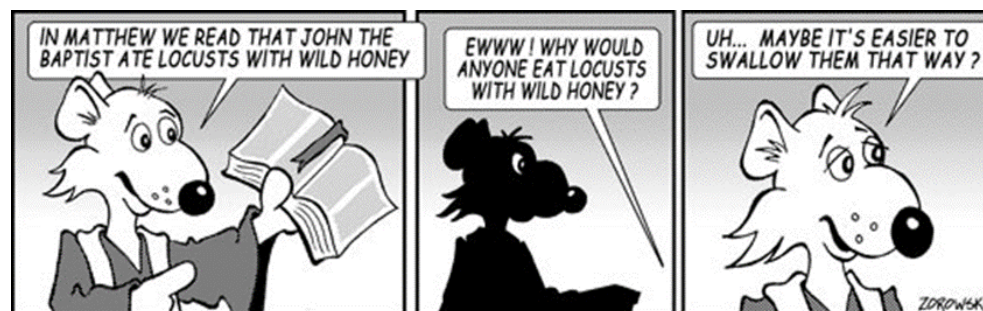


While I was a pastor at Lebanon, Pa., I called one day at the home of a parishioner and found the lady in great distress and sorrow. Wringing her hands, she cried: "What shall I do—what shall I do?" I replied, "You cannot do better than to take it all to Jesus—you must tell Jesus." For a moment she seemed abstracted in meditation, then her face glowed, her eyes lighted up, and with animation she exclaimed, "Yes, I must tell Jesus, I must tell Jesus!" As I went from that sorrow-filled home a vision walked before me, a vision of a joy-illuminated face, of a soul transformed from darkness into light, and I heard all along my pathway the echo of a tender voice saying, "I must tell Jesus!"
