Hymn Story:

Our last hymn this morning is “To God Be The Glory”, was written by Frances Jane van Alstyne (née Crosby; 1820 – 1915), commonly known as Fanny Crosby. Despite being blind from early childhood, Mrs. Crosby was successful as a mission worker, a public speaker, and most notably, as a poet. She is credited with writing more than 8,000 hymns, 7 of which are in our Methodist hymnal. “To God Be The Glory”, was a favorite of Cliff Barrows who sang in the Billy Graham crusades and introduced it to millions of Americans. She wrote of the miracles that God has done and that God will yet do. Notice that Mrs. Crosby’s hymn ends with her hope that in heaven she will be able to see again.

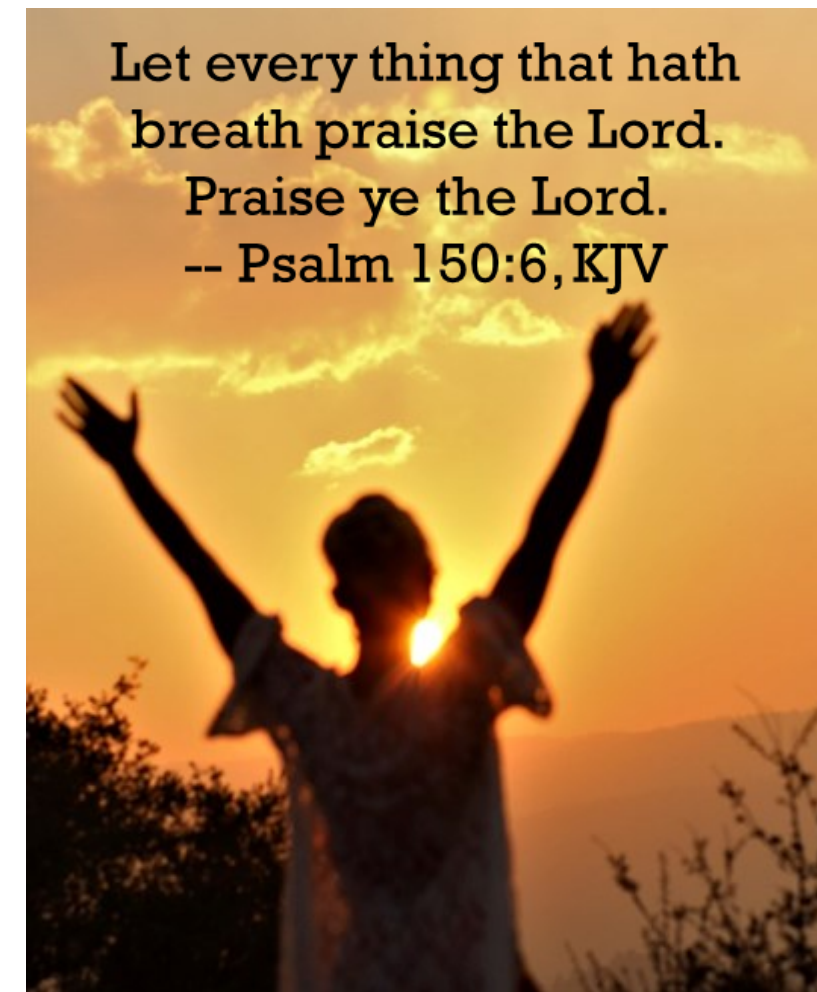
