Hymn Story:

Our last hymn this morning is “**Fairest Lord Jesus.**” The song invites the singer to recognize that Jesus is greater and more wonderful than all the natural world. The hymn is anonymous but is thought to have come out of the German Jesuit community. It was first published by Munster Gesangbuch in a German hymnal in 1677 and translated into English in 1873 by Joseh Seiss. Hymns like this remind us of our rich heritage in Christian music.

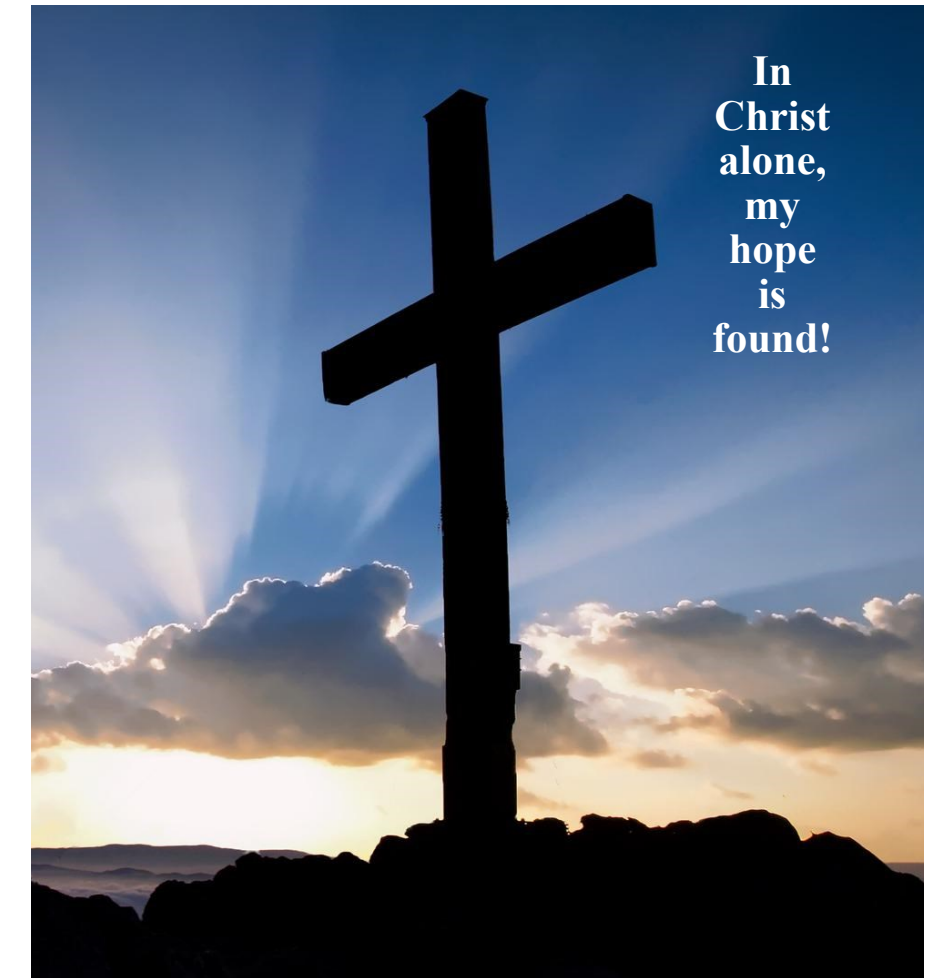
QUOTABLES:
