HYMN STORY:

Our anthem today is, "How Firm a Foundation" was first published in 1787 in a hymnbook edited by John Rippon, the hymn is credited to "K." Whoever this is, their hymn has become one of America's most loved, and was said to have been sung at the death bed of President Andrew Jackson and at the funerals of General Robert E. Lee and Presidents Theodore Roosevelt, President Woodrow Wilson, and others. It was so popular in the 1860's that soldiers from both sides were reported to have been singing it. Verse 2 is especially strong:

Fear not, I am with thee, O be not dismayed; For I am thy God and will still give thee aid; I'll strengthen thee, help thee and cause thee to stand, Upheld by My righteous, omnipotent hand.




