DAY CARE:

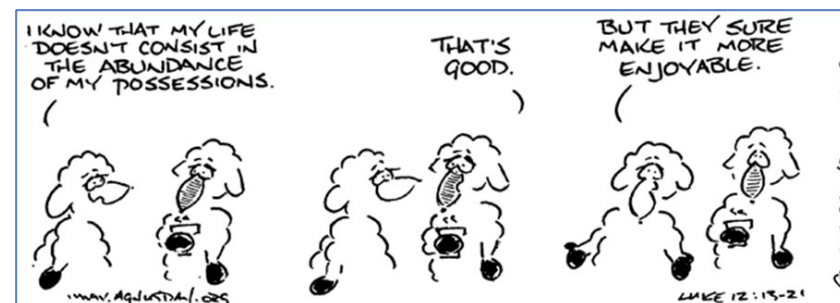

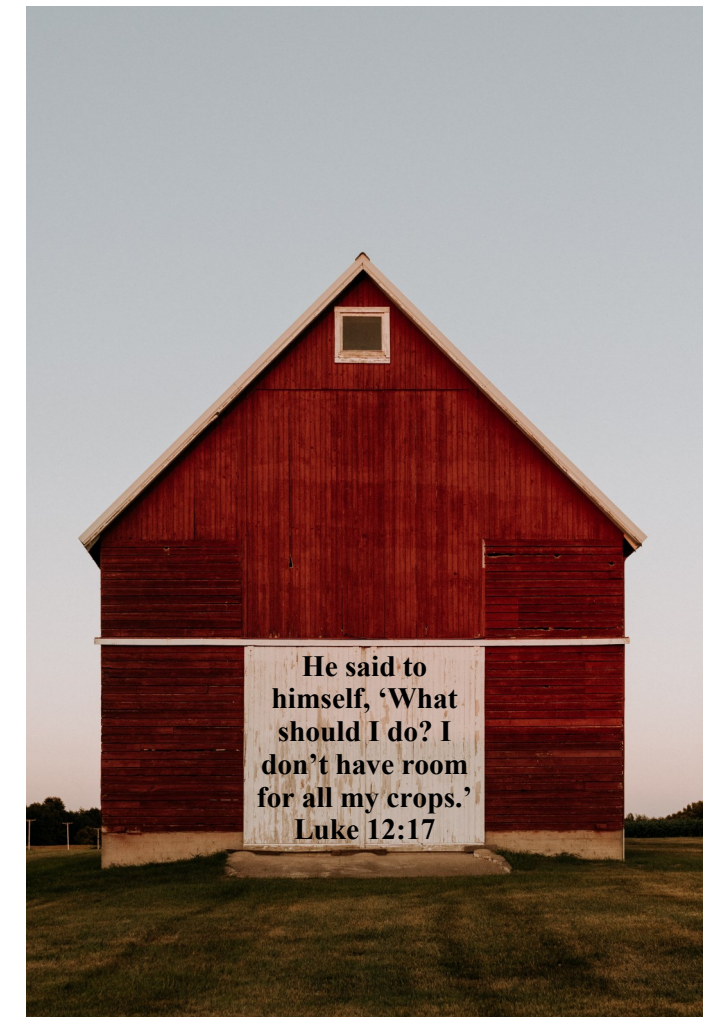
