### HYMN STORIES:

Our middle hymn today, **Sweet Hour of Prayer**, was written by William W. Walford. It is not about group prayer. Rather, it invites the singer to imagine themselves seeking God while alone in prayer. The author, William Walford, was a rural English blind poet, tinker, and lay preacher. He evidently would compose and memorize his poems, and shared from memory the finished pieces. A visitor from New York, named Thomas Salmon heard the poem, wrote down the words and sent it to a Christian magazine called, "The Observer." It was published in the Observer on September 13, 1845. The composer, William Bradbury, (known for "Just As I Am", "The Solid Rock", and "He Leadeth Me") saw the poem and set it to music in 1861. It is as if God wanted the poem to get out to the world. It has been a standard in hymnals ever since.

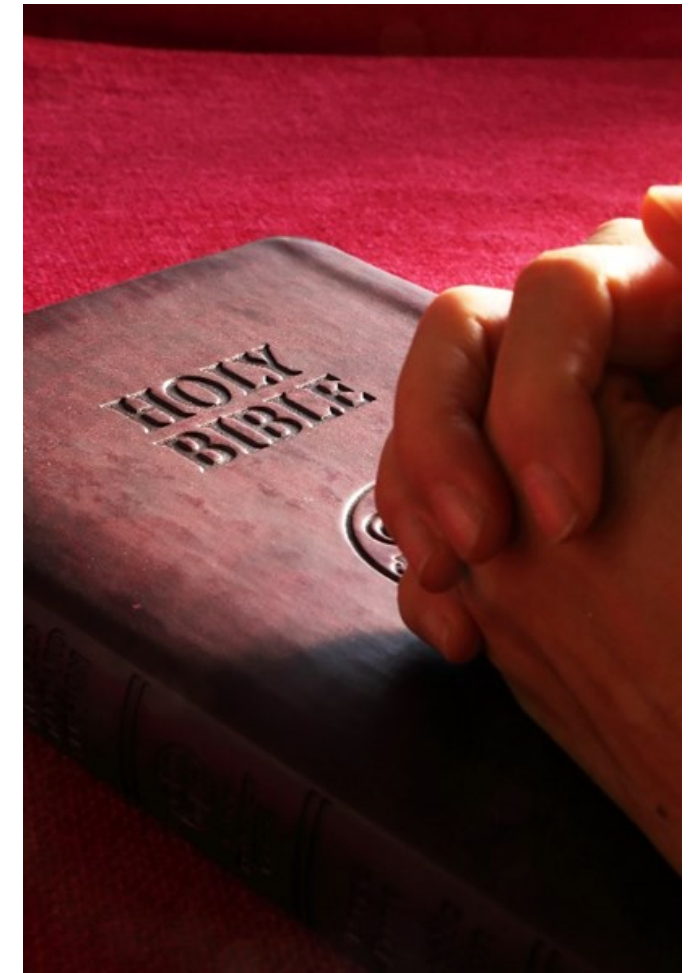
