The Superior Court of Cobb County, Judge Steven Schuster ruled that United Methodist churches have a limited right to vote on disaffiliation, based on the terms already established in the Book of Discipline. Given that ruling, the 186 churches that have requested the option to vote must be allowed to do so. Other terms, such as when an Annual Conference meeting will occur to ratify those votes, are left to be decided so our journey is not over yet. But today represents such significant progress. ... More than 200 people filled the courtroom (plus two overflow rooms). There was a lot of support and folks were particularly respectful. The judge was also warm, respectful, and honest. We can be grateful for the way he handled this case. In other news, Mann-Mize and Trinity on the Hill both held their votes today. Mann-Mize voted 100% to leave. Trinity on the Hill passed their vote with 95.04% voting yes. Our one conviction through this whole process has been that churches deserve to make decisions based on agreed-upon processes. We are grateful that the court agrees this to be our legal right. Much more, we trust this will be the first step toward ending the lamentable contention in our Conference and the beginning of reconciliation and peace.
