PLANNING FOR 2023

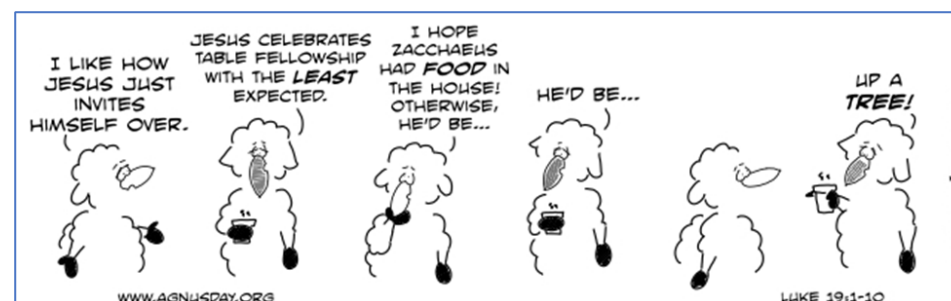
