Tomorrow night at 6 PM, we will have our quarterly Administrative Council Meeting. There is a lot to talk about, and everyone is welcome!



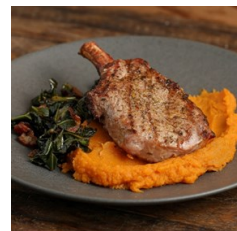
## WOMEN OF THE FLAME

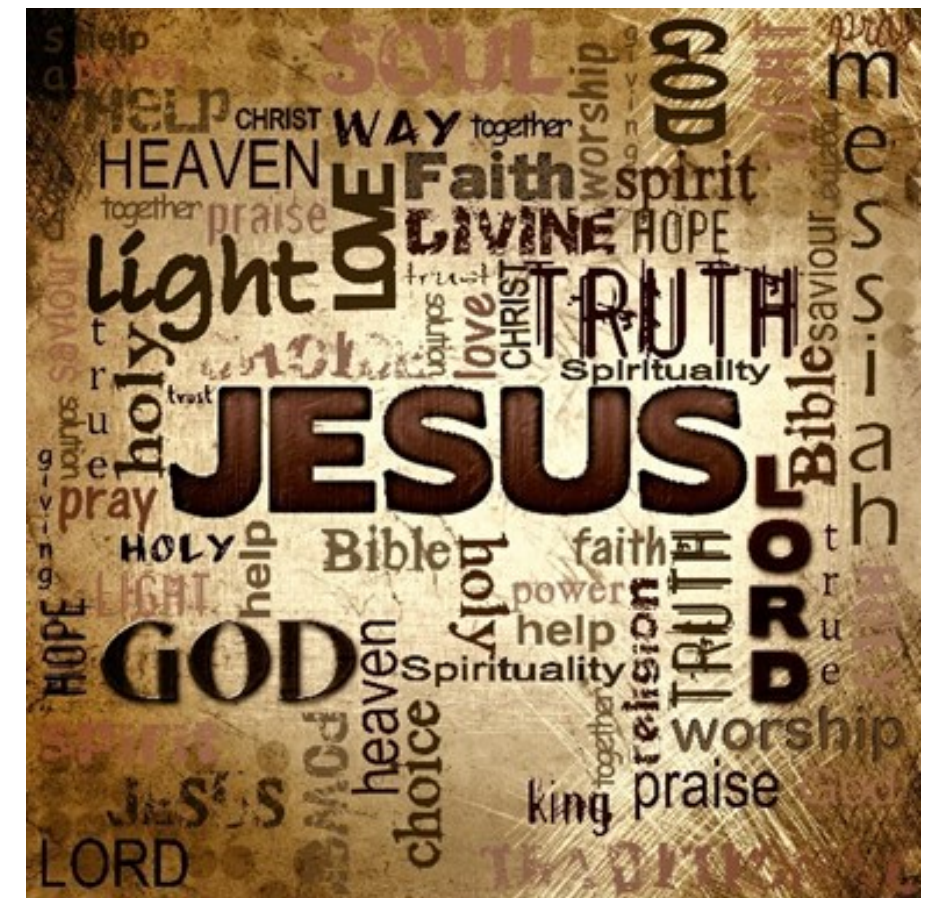
