Join us in a time of prayer on the 1st and 3rd Tuesday at 3 PM—October 4th and 18th. All are welcome.

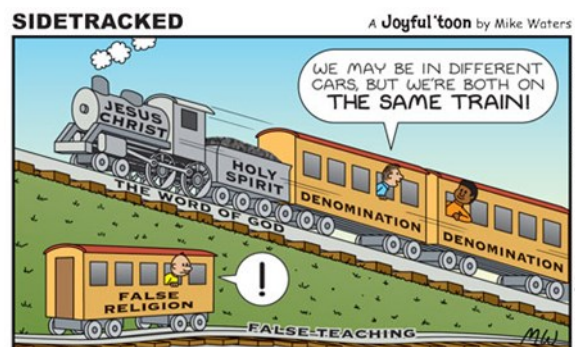
FELLOWSHIP LUNCH
