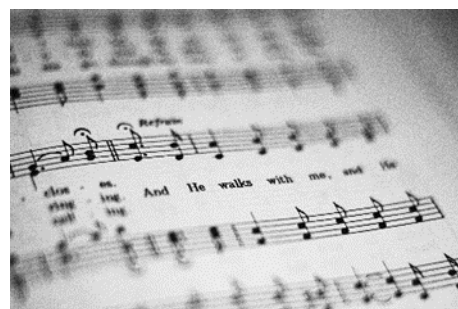

TUESDAY PRAYER MEETING:

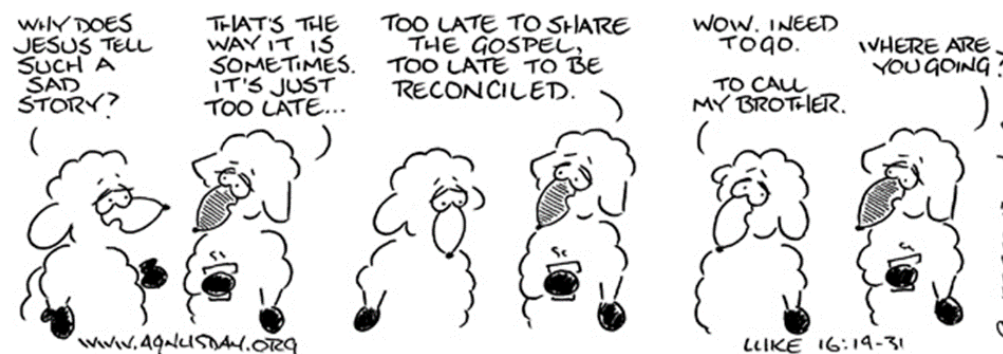
