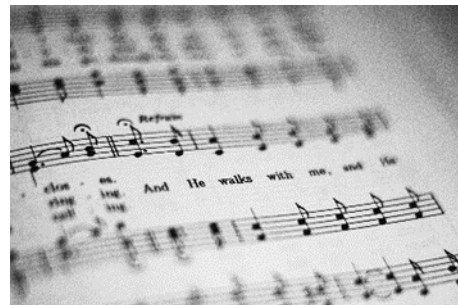
AUGUSTA GARDENS

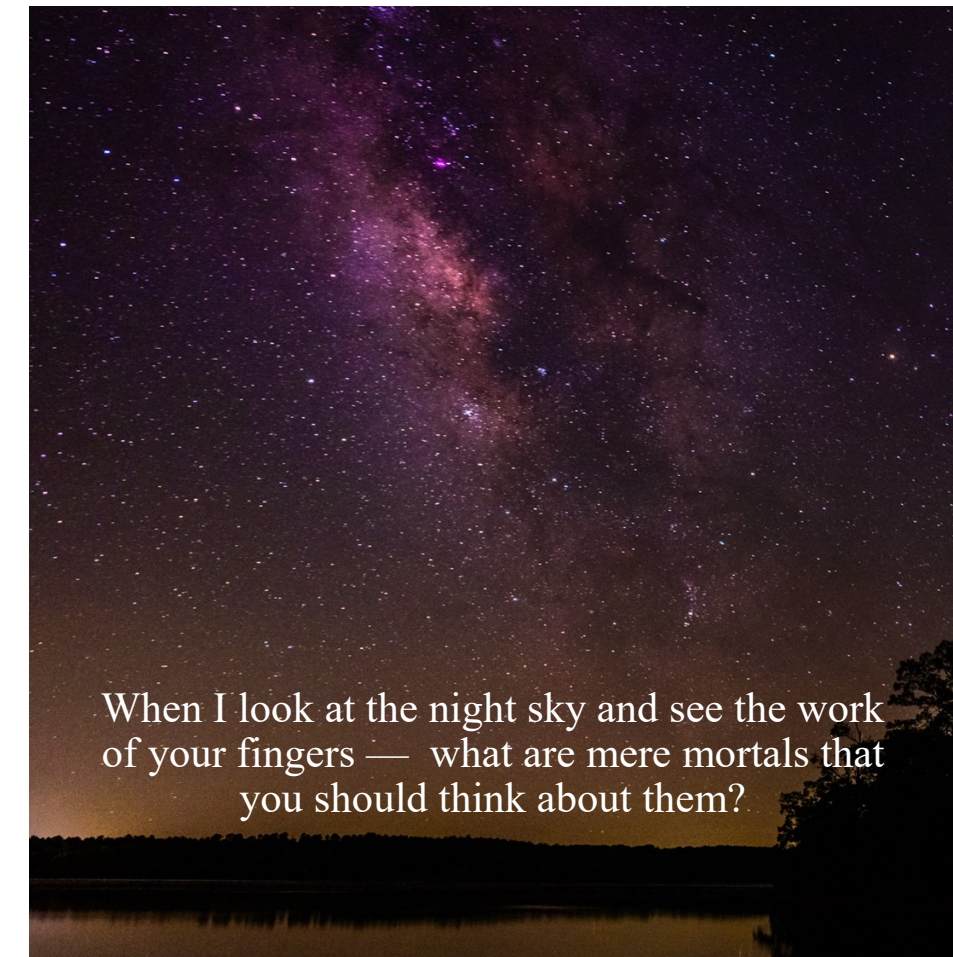
