A "HOMEMADE" ICE CREAM SOCIAL:

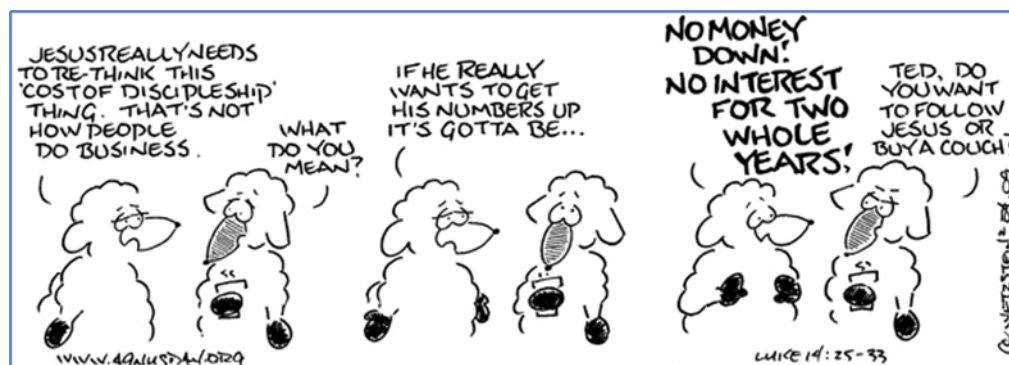

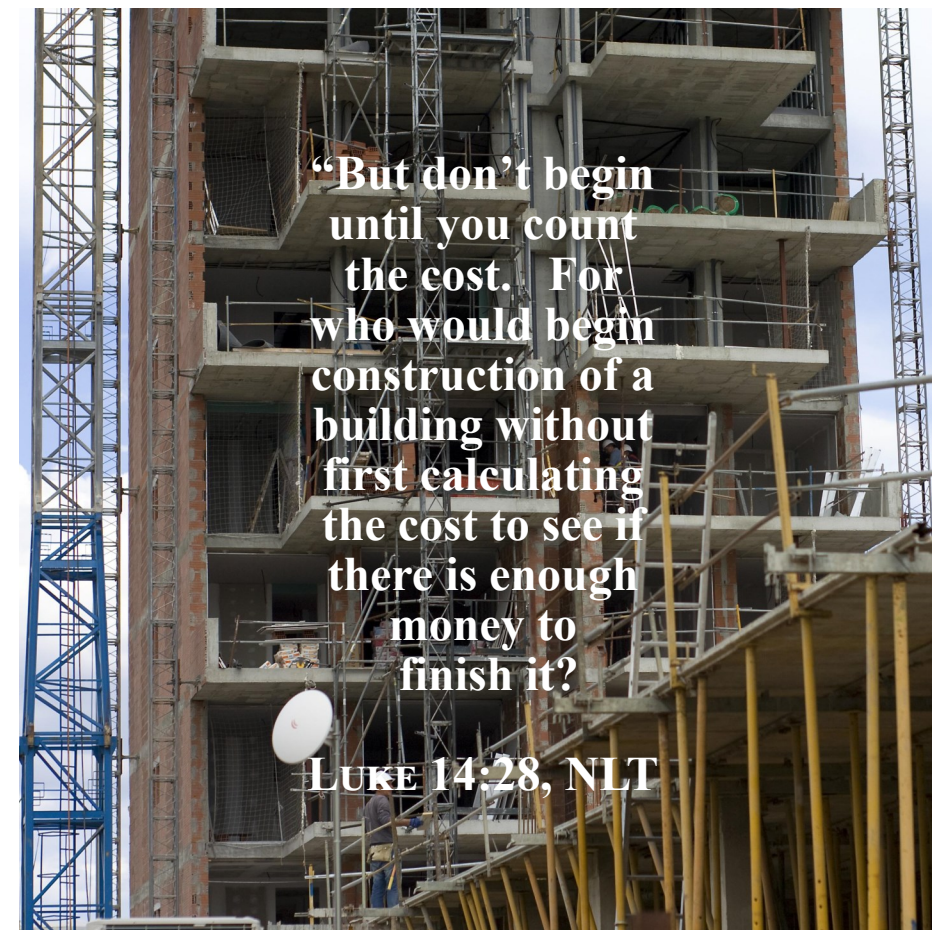
