Rev. Terry Fleming, our beloved former District Superintendent, wrote an article a few weeks ago that I think really describes the Christian life. Here are his words.

"There is a channel of water that connects the Black Sea with the Mediterranean Sea. It is the Bosporus, also called the Strait of Istanbul. It was (and is) an important route for navigation, and of course sailing ships typically go with the flow – which is southward. But since at least the 8th century, ship's captains knew that there was ANOTHER current in that strait. It flows northward, deep beneath the surface. They would fill their nets with rocks and lower them several fathoms down and their ships would move – as if by magic – against the stream. No sails, no motor, no oars giving momentum – just sailing against the current.

Today we are awash with the currents of our culture – fear, hostility, conspiracy – we are bathing in all that through social media or mass media. It is simplistic itself to join the lynch mob, left or right; to jump on that bandwagon, and join our voices and our anger in the riot.

I think that the Christian believer should stand apart. We stand rooted – or better yet, we sail - AGAINST the direction of the mob. It is as if we heard the beat of a different drummer, or were warmed by another sun, so we effortlessly swim north while all about us are swimming south. How is this possible? Because of whose we are, because our souls are linked to the vine – Christ himself.

Chesterton gave the famous quote, "A dead thing can go with the stream, but only a living thing can go against it (The Everlasting Man)."

This is the key of the Christian life. Faith in Christ – not the words, the real thing – means we are rooted and anchored and attached to the life of Christ. In the surface, we live out our lives materially, physically, bodily. But somehow, some way, our essential soul is connected beyond the veil, to eternity, to heaven, to something and someone BEYOND. In a very real sense, we are called to consider our earthly lives as already dead - certainly dying and passing away - but our essential life "is hidden with Christ in God (Col. 3:3)." And there OUGHT to be evidence of that new Christ-life flowing out of us in our behavior, in our words, in our love...and in our calmness, when everyone about us is losing their ever-loving minds!"

Terry's words remind me of the Henry David Thoreau's quote, "If a man does not keep pace with his companions, perhaps it is because he hears a different drummer. Let him step to the Continued on page 2
