

From The Pastor

When I was in middle school in the early 1970's I lived for several years on Talahi Island, near Wilmington Island, out from Savannah. And in the 1980's when I was in the Marines, I was stationed for a couple years in up in Beaufort, SC. Suffice it to say, I love the low-country.



I was pleased in 2001 when an given the opportunity to serve as an Associate Pastor at a Savannah church -- Skidaway Island

UMC. I was at Skidaway for three wonderful years, met many remarkable people and made lots of good friends. Since leaving I have kept up with several members and I've kept up with the church. So it was very interesting to see this week that Skidaway Island UMC is no longer a UMC. They voted to disaffiliate; and they were among the 193 congregations in the South Georgia Conference to have their disaffiliations ratified by a Special Called Annual Conference in South Georgia last Sunday, May 21. Skidaway Methodist Church has now joined the Global Methodist Church. The pastor at Skidaway, Hale Bishop, is a friend of mine. When I was at Skidaway he served at Tybee and would call himself "the Bishop of Tybee." On occasion I would preach at Trinity UMC on Tybee when Hale was out of town. In their May newsletter, called "The Parish Voice," Hale wrote the following:

"While we have voted to leave the United Methodist Church and join the Global Methodist Church, I assure you that we remain thoroughly Methodist. We continue in the heritage of John Wesley. We hold the scriptures sacred, adhere to the discipline, affirm our creedal faith, hold true to the "Articles of Religion", and our history as Methodists. This congregation has always intentionally welcomed all to worship and to the community of faith. ... We have been and will continue to be a welcoming congregation.

Burns Memorial UMC is having a Called Church Conference to vote on disaffiliation at the church on Tuesday, July 11 at 6 PM. All Professing Members present may vote, and it requires a 2/3 vote of the members present in favor of disaffiliation to put Burns Memorial on the list of churches to be voted on at a November 18, Special Called North Georgia Annual Conference.

As with Skidaway, whatever the result – regardless of whether we vote to stay with the United Methodist Church, become an Independent Methodist Church, or join the Global Methodist

Church, we **will** continue to be Methodists. We will hold fast to the faith passed down to us, welcome all with love, and seek to live out our love of God by loving our neighbors as ourselves.
