There has been so much sad news lately in America. Thursday night, April 13, in Kansas City, Missouri, 16-year-old **Ralph Yarl** was shot twice when knocking on the wrong door. Ralph, an outstanding high school student and musician, was simply trying to pick up his younger brothers; they were actually at a house not very far away. Still able to walk, Ralph fled the house and sought help at several homes before finding someone willing to get involved. He was hospitalized over the weekend and is now recovering back at his home. Thankfully, he is expected to make a full recovery.





20-year-old **Kaylin Gillis** was not so fortunate. On Saturday night, April 15, in Hebron, New York, the honor student and several friends were on their way to a party. Their GPS failed them, and they went to the wrong home. Before they could even get out of the car to knock, the homeowner fired a round into the car, killing Kaylin.

These two news stories keep replaying in my mind. I grieve with the Yarl and Gillis families, and for the Kansas City and Hebron communities, and I grieve for America. What has happened to America that so many of our citizens are afraid of each other? When did it become normal to answer the door with a loaded gun in hand ready to fire at the least cause, or even for no cause at all? My friends and fellow Christians, let's not be this way. The world around us may be filled with fear and hate, but we are disciples of Jesus Christ. Let's show the world a better way. Say it with me.
