From The Pastor

The Administrative Council voted on September 19 to form an Exploratory Committee to learn more about the process by which many United Methodist Churches are leaving the denomination. This process is called "disaffiliation." Our District Superintendent, Rev. Dr. Greg Porterfield, met with the Exploratory Committee on Monday night, September 26, clarifying the process. Many details on this process can be found at the North Georgia UMC Web Page, www.ngumc.org/disaffiliation-process-and-information. Here are some of the highlights of the Conference policy.

The Conference Board of Trustees have presented a process for disaffiliation that was established by the 2019 General Conference of The United Methodist Church. This is Paragraph 2553 of the Book of Discipline.

The steps include the instructions that to proceed, a two-thirds majority of the professing members of the local church present and voting at the church conference approve the resolution to disaffiliate from The United Methodist Church. The resolution must then be ratified by the members of the North Georgia Annual Conference.

Prior to the disaffiliation date, a local church shall pay to the Annual Conference any unpaid apportionments for the 12 months immediately prior and an additional 12 months of apportionments, plus unfunded pension obligations, direct-bill obligations, and other liabilities.

In churches where the church council and clergy sense that a large portion of a congregation may wish to consider disaffiliation from The United Methodist Church under Paragraph 2553 of the Book of Discipline, they should first reach out to their District Superintendent.

Churches that discern that they would like to request a church conference to vote on disaffiliation will make their request to their District Superintendent. Superintendents will receive requests between January 1 and February 28, 2023. After February 28, church conferences will be scheduled by the District Superintendent.

We will be having open meetings to discuss the pros and cons of disaffiliation on Sunday, October 16 and Sunday November 13. Both these meetings are at 1:30 PM. Please be in prayer for our church during this season of discernment. My hope is that whether we stay or go, we are able to do it together.

The Burns Memorial UMC Missions Committee met on August 30, and among other decisions they voted to continue generous support for the **Compass for Hope** (ministry to the Augusta Homeless population), **Safe Homes** (emergency shelter for battered women), and **I-Care** (ministry to help victims of sexual trafficking).
